2. BLACK TAP

Burger • SoHo

Since opening earlier this year, Black Tap has been lauded by some as “the best new burger spot in Manhattan.” Creative accoutrements are paired with grilled patties made from a 50/50 mix of chuck and brisket — as well as grass-fed lamb, chorizo and organic turkey. Each sandwich comes with fries. An additional \$2 gets diners, onion rings, sweet potato fries, house salad or one of the modern sides (think Mexican avocado, crispy Brussels sprouts and teriyaki broccoli).
