Instead, this comfortable hotel is a perfect home-away-from-home for those looking for a terrific bang for the buck. Its enviable location puts this hotel smack dab in the heart of midtown's action. Business travelers flock here for access to area offices, but it's also a great choice for vacationers who want to traipse over to Central Park or hit up the shops on Fifth Avenue.

Everything about The Blakely feels like a classic New York residence. At first glance, the brick façade and blue awning could easily be mistaken for a private building, but it's the inside where guests feel immediately at home. The hotel shows off its old bones with terrific wood floors and large wood-framed windows.
